

## **Cougar Cookers Scholarship**

The University of Houston Cougar Cookers announces the availability of a \$1500 scholarship for a student who has demonstrated leadership in Frontier Fiesta. This scholarship encourages student participation and leadership in the planning, organization and implementation of Frontier Fiesta on behalf of the University of Houston community.

### **The Scholarship**

The scholarship is a one-time award in the amount of \$1500 paid in two installments in Fall 2010 and Spring 2011. The award will be made to a volunteer student leader who has proven a past commitment of leadership to Frontier Fiesta and continues to maintain active involvement following receipt of the award. The recipient must continue his/her involvement with Frontier Fiesta throughout the 2010 spring semester in an unpaid position. The scholarship will be awarded contingent upon the student remaining in good standing at the University of Houston, making satisfactory progress towards a University of Houston degree, and maintaining a full-time course load (12 hours).

### **Eligibility**

The selection committee shall consider past and current involvement and leadership and the student's intent of future unpaid participation in Frontier Fiesta. The committee shall determine the relative weight given to each criterion. There are no restrictions to applicants based on sex, race, nationality, country of origin, physical disability, veteran status, or sexual orientation.

Recipients of the award shall not forfeit other scholarship, grants, or awards to which they are entitled. However, if a recipient applies for financial aid, the amount of the award may be used in calculating the total amount of aid for which the student is eligible.

### **Application Deadline**

**All application materials must be received by May 31, 2010.**
